INFORMATION SHEET

Uniforms: League will provide jersey with number, hat, and socks.

Extras: Each player will also be covered by Little League insurance, and be provided with a parent handbook, pictures, trophy, and yearbook.

Divisions:
T-Ball – 4 and 5 year olds
Single A – 6 and 7 year olds
Double A – 7, 8, 9 year olds
Triple A – 9, 10, and 11 year olds
Majors – 11 and 12 year olds
Juniors – 13 and 14 year olds

Tryouts: All players that will be 8 years old or older by May 1st, must tryout. 7 year olds that would like to play in the Double A division, may request a tryout. Tryouts will be on January 15th, unless it rains. You will receive a card in the mail the week before tryouts with your specific time for the tryout.

Teams: Majors, AAA, and AA will be put together the last week in January. Single A and T-Ball will be put together the first week in February. If you do not know what team you are on by February 12th, please call the player agent, Guillermo Valdez at 213-503-1365.

Practices: Practices will be scheduled by the manager once your child is on a team.
